This program improved the safety of the site, enhanced the construction productivity, worked well with my current supervisory roles, and I would use it again. It is in the best interest of all builders to manage their waste and AET's program does that for them. By managing and separating waste properly the site supervisor is empowered to, see where materials are being wasted and can thereby reduce the amount of material being used and/or sent to landfill. The program is easy to follow, anyone can come up to the standards of the program, and it only requires a change in the site culture. I feel the program would be even more affective if AET were to train the builders staff and sub-trades, provide an AET staff member to work along with the builder's staff for a period of one to three months or until the builders staff was able to perform the labour component of the program, leaving AET free to manage and recycle the waste stream that would be separated and curb sided by the builder's staff.
